The Victorian School of Languages (VSL) is Victoria's official Department of Education and Training (DET) distance education provider for languages.

Each year over 1500 students from government and non-government schools take advantage of the range of languages offered by VSL Distance Education.

VSL Distance Education students perform well above average on a state-wide comparison each year, and almost one-third of VSL VCE students are among the top scorers.

Students eligible for enrolment in Victorian government or non-government secondary schools may enrol, provided their home school ensures that applications meet VSL requirements.

Reasons for choosing to study with VSL Distance Education include:

- The language a student wishes to study is unavailable at their home school.
- A timetable clash prevents a student from studying the language of their choice at their home school.
- A student is studying with Virtual School Victoria (VSV).
- Approved home schooling.

All students must have an address in Victoria.

**Chinese, Indonesian and Japanese have First and Second Language options at VCE level. Accelerated courses are offered in French, German, Italian, Latin and Spanish.*

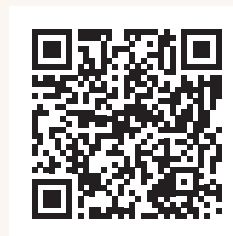
